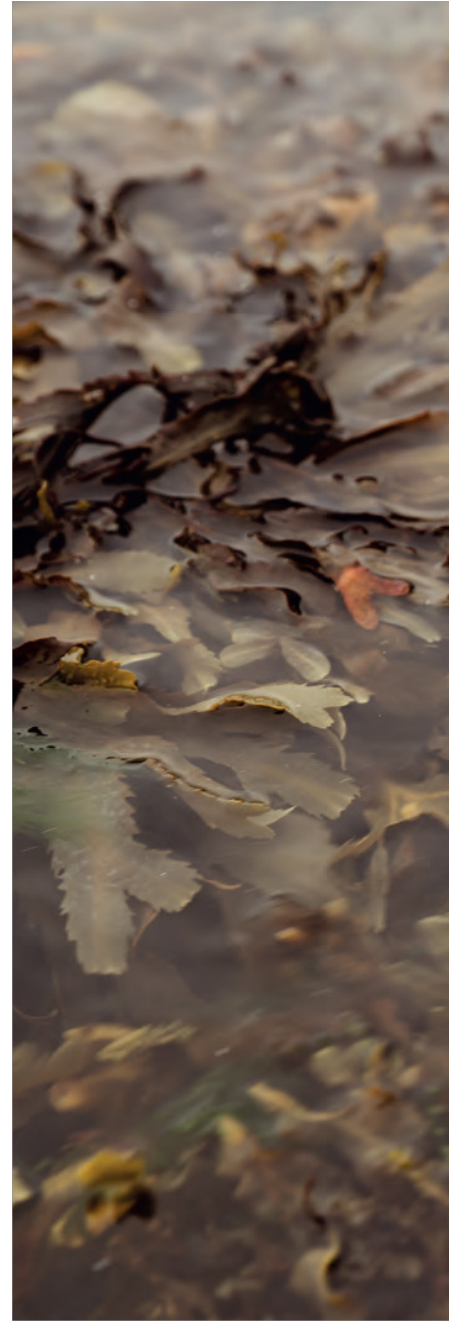
There is great uncertainty in life and leadership. In uncertainty, we tend to look to leaders to lead: to know, and be all-knowing.

shape




The process of making
